First Quad-Stack™ 4 Color Unit for Vietnam

The first Quad-Stack™ to enter the country of Vietnam has been installed at Le Quang Loc in Ho Chi Minh City.

“Our international sales team in Asia has been working many months to achieve this goal,” states Mark Ricca, President of Web Press Corporation and its international sales subsidiary, Web Leader International, Inc. “We have a unique product which is very popular in the Western Hemisphere and some areas of Europe, but convincing companies in Asia of its great value has been a challenge. We are pleased that Le Quang Loc has seen this vision.”

The Quad-Stack™ 414+4 is a uniquely configured single-width one-around press that boasts not only a standard unit footprint, but a convenient 3 meter height. Most conventional four-color “towers” are 4.5 to 6.5 meters high. Due to its compact nature, the unit fits in plants with lower ceiling heights, which gives it a niche market. However, printing plants of all shapes and sizes are purchasing the Quad-Stack™ for its capabilities.

The Quad-Stack™ when combined with servo-driven technology, can be merged with equipment manufactured by other companies, such as Goss, Harris, DGM, Tensor, and Solna. The LQL installation involves installing the Quad-Stack™ unit into an older Harris V30 press line.

Standard Quad-Stack™ units can be upgraded to include such items as double oscillators, ink levers rather than screws, and automatic inking systems, to name a few. Complete plate changes can be done on the compact unit in 5 to 8 minutes. Registration is held tight, as there is no web stretch between ink decks. Customers are reporting make-ready figures in the low 200 copies.

“This is huge,” states Ricca. “Customers with competitive equipment tell us their previous make-ready figures were in the thousands. Being in the low hundreds makes a tremendous difference in their bottom line.”

The Quad-Stack™ can also be used with UV lights to produce semi-commercial, glossy coated-stock products, such as magazines, brochures, and inserts.

LQL’s anchor publication is Tuoi Tre Newspaper, the voice of the Youth Union of HCMC. In addition, they print publications for the Saigon Times Group, HCMC Law Newspaper, Popular Sciences Newspaper, the products of Khan Quang Do Newspaper, Fine Arts Magazine, and Nice House Magazine.
